Pupil survey results 2016

In the summer term, a pupil survey was conducted to gather opinion on the following five questions:

When asked 'How well do you feel you are progressing (improving) in school?' Children rated their progress as an average of **9.2** on a scale from 1 (lowest) to 10 (Highest).

96% of children answered that they are pleased with their progress in school.

On a scale of 1 - 10 for how well-motivated children feel in school (How much they want to do well), children rated their motivation as **9.6**.

89% of children feel that their opinions are sought on school matters.

96% of children feel that being a Rights Respecting school helps them enjoy their school life.

We are very happy with the pupil responses in the survey and feel that it demonstrates that children at Firs Farm are happy and engaged with their learning.
