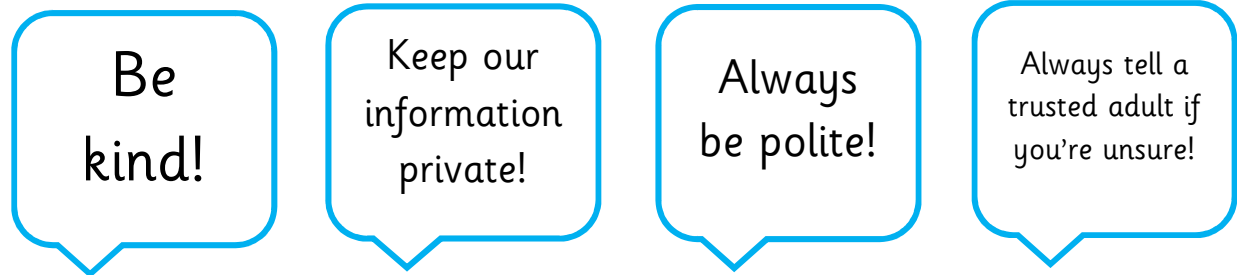


Online Safety workshops
