

3H in June, 2018.



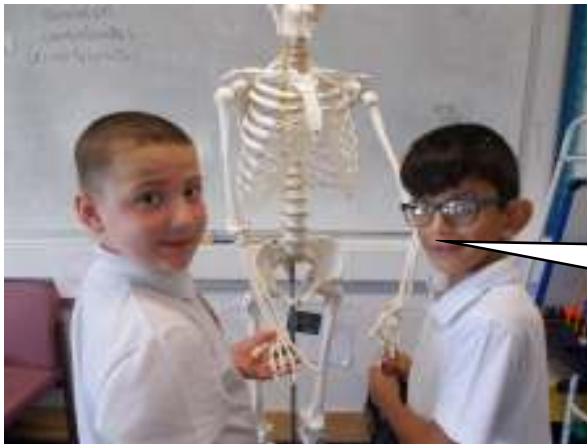
While 12 of the class were celebrating Eid, the rest of us investigated square numbers. Can you see we built to $8 \times 8 = 64$?
