- preventing impairment of children's health or development,
- ensuring that children grow up in circumstances consistent with the provision of safe and effective care,
- taking action to enable all children to have the best outcomes.

Safe and Secure Environment

- Safety checks on equipment
- Regular site checks
- Fire alarms and evacuation procedures
- Staff : pupil ratios at playtimes/lunchtimes
- Secure gates
- Signing in system
- All adults wear lanyards
- Named Health and Safety Officers



Health Needs

- Trained Welfare Officer
- First Aid trained staff – who attend all trips
